

Q: How to use the OFF Mode function in Macro Setting

A: The Off Mode can found in the Option menu of the Macro Setup. Please follow the below example on how to use the Off Mode correctly.

Example: Macro: IF PIR Triggered THEN SmartPlug "ON", set the duration 30 sec.

This Macro will have 2 different results after the PIR has been triggered.

1. When the Smartplug status is "OFF" before the Macro has been triggered: After the trigger of the Macro the Smartplug will turn "On" and 30 sec later, the Smartplug will be in status "OFF" status.
2. When the Smartplug status is "ON" before the Macro has been triggered: After the trigger of the Macro the Smartplug will off course be "On" but 30 sec later, the Smartplug will be in status "ON". So the Smartplug will not turn off.

The Macro duration logic is to set back the device to the "last status", this depends on device status before the Macro triggered.

To now make sure the Smartplug goes turn Off in point 2, we added the OFF mode function to make all "Then device" to the status "OFF" when the duration time up.

For Point 2 to turn off the device the Macro would be IF PIR Trigger THEN Smartplug On, Duration 30 sec and OFF Mode enabled.
